



CALL FOR EXPRESSION OF INTERESTS/PROPOSALS

Oxfam in Cambodia has its country strategy for the period from 2015-2020. The country strategy will help Oxfam to sharpen its direction, re-strategy ways of working with effectiveness and efficiency use of resources with the aim to achieve the desired goal of realizing the power of people against poverty. Oxfam in Cambodia envisions, that "Cambodians, especially women and youth, are empowered to hold government and others with power accountable to realize their right to build a resilient society free from poverty and injustice".

Oxfam Country Strategy is realized **Gender Justice** is at the center of all programmes as this is very crucial to achieve its vision in Cambodia. **Gender justice program** aims to empower women to exercise their power over their lives and have their lives free from violence. The key focus is to promote women's leadership especially young women in public and politics both in formal elected and representational and in informal leadership role at all levels, and to raise women's voice to be heard and addressed. Evidence-based advocacy and campaigning that promote women's rights and leadership, and the ending of gender based violence will be held with partners and other key stakeholders at sub-national and national levels. Our approaches are to build and strengthening networking, coordination with network of women NGOs, young women, and development partners and strategic government agencies. Oxfam Great Britain (OGB) will lead and coordinate with the others toward the achievement the following programme goal and objectives.

Program Change Goal: Women, especially young women are empowered to realize their rights and play a leadership role in building an inclusive society free from poverty and injustice.

Program Change Objectives:

- More women, esp. young women will be able to claim their rights through active participation in decision-making structures at all levels.
- Violence against women will be eliminated through efforts by civil society working with Government and diverse actors across society
- More women will be able to access and control resources critical for their livelihoods and exercise their rights.

To achieve these change objectives, OGB is calling for Expression of Interest (EOI)/proposals from the national Women NGO's who have similar goals and objectives with concrete knowledge and experience to support in implement this program. The proposal should cover goal, change objective, outcomes and activities, along with the project log frame, budgets and your organization capacity to deliver these objectives and outcomes.

Grant Size: 60,000 USD per proposal
