“CSO Accountability in the Context of Post LANGO and SDGs”

06 October 2015, at KSSA (Diakonia Center)

1 Rationale

Last CCC bi-monthly meeting in August 2015 was a platform for sharing the global movement including sustainable development goals (SDGs), financing for development, global reference standards for CSO Accountability, creation of sub-committee for CCC. Speakers from government, UN Agencies, private sector and CSOs were invited to that meeting. Feedback from the meeting required CCC to have broader and deeper discussion on location of SDGs and CSO’s preparation for post LANGOs.

Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) will be adopted in the UN General Assembly to be held in last week of September 2015 and Cambodia. At the same time, the Law on Associations and NGOs (LANGOs) has been promulgated by the King in 12 August 2015 and it has a lot of requirements for CSOs to comply with. These two movements have a lot of implications for civil society organizations, one of which is demanding CSOs more accountable and transparent and well preparedness to comply with the laws and to adopt the SDGs into their programs/projects. It is very important for civil society organizations, especially CCC members who have been the main drivers of CSOs in Cambodia to have broadened discussions, and well prepared to comply with the LANGO and to localize SDGs.

In according with the feedback from the last bi-monthly meeting and recent development, the 6 October 2015 CCC’s Bi-monthly meeting will be a great opportunity for members to meet various experts on Accountability of CSOs and SDGs from national and global levels as panelist to share and debate on CSO Accountability in the context of SDGs and LANGO. At the meeting, there will be a researcher to present his study on “Localization and Financing for Sustainable Development Goals”. At the same, CCC will share a summary result of membership satisfactory survey conducted in earlier 2015 and a plan for another one to be conducted from October 2015.

2. Objectives

- To celebrate new members and new accreditation of CCC as a role model organization with good governance and professional practices.
- To discuss and debate on CSO Accountability in the context of Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and LANGOs
- To discuss on implications and strategies to mitigate any impacts from LANGO
- To share result of membership satisfactory survey conducted during CCC AGM 2015 and conduct a new survey and need assessment for 2016.
- To present his study on “Localization and Financing for Sustainable Development Goals” and summary of the UN General Assembly on approval to the SDGs 2016-2030.

3. Participants

It is expected that the consultation will be participated by around 160 senior representatives from CCC members and non-members, speakers, media, government, and development partners.
